Interpretation of the KBIT-2 and KTEA-II scores

KBIT-2 results are given in three parts: Verbal, Nonverbal and a composite IQ score reflecting a child's performance as a whole. Overall (composite) IQ scores range from 40 to 160. Scores above 130 are considered within the gifted range. Children scoring 130 and above are candidates for advanced placement programs, schools and classes.

KBIT Test FAQ - The Test Tutor

The composite IQ score is found by converting your child's raw score (total number of correct answers) on the verbal and nonverbal subtests into a standard score. This score is provided on the traditional scale, with 100 serving as the mean and 15 as the standard deviation. The KBIT's overall IQ score ranges from 40-160.

Converting Raw Scores to Standard Scores (IQs)

A score of 132 means 2 standard deviations above the mean or at the 97.8 percentile—a score higher than 97.8% of aged peers. A score of 148 is 3 standard deviations above the mean, or at the 99.9th percentile, which is a “1 in a 1,000” situation. The same goes for scores below the mean (100), for by the same standard deviation of 16.
