Metabolic surgery can cause amelioration, resolution, and possible cure of type 2 diabetes. Bariatric surgery is metabolic surgery. In the future, there will be metabolic surgery operations to treat type 2 diabetes that are not focused on weight loss. These procedures will rely on neurohormonal modulation related to the gut as well as outside the peritoneal cavity.

### Metabolic (Bariatric and Nonbariatric) Surgery for Type 2 ...

Whereas bariatric surgery is generally performed in patients with a body mass index (BMI) of at least 40 kg/m<sup>2</sup> (or ≥35 kg/m<sup>2</sup> with comorbidities), the STAMPEDE metabolic surgery clinical trial in patients with type 2 diabetes included participants with BMIs as low as 27 kg/m<sup>2</sup> [2].
