Power is produced by an overhead valve, 1.8 litre naturally aspirated 4 cylinder powerplant, with 2 valves per cylinder that produces power and torque figures of 95 bhp (96 PS/71 kW) at 5400 rpm and 149 N·m (110 lb·ft/15.2 kgm) at 3000 rpm respectively.

Mechanically an evolution of the MGA it replaced, the MGB was powered by a 1,798cc B-Series engine rated at 95 bhp and mated to a four-speed manual transmission with synchromesh on the top three gears and an optional overdrive.

1962 MG MGB T he MGB was introduced at the London Motor Show in 1962 and would become one of the most successful sports cars ever made. It replaced the MGA in 1963 and production of the MGB and its variants would continue until 1980. Combined sales of the MGB, MGC and MGB GT V8 totaled 523,836 cars.

Combined production volume of MGB, MGC and MGB GT V8 models was 523,836 cars. A very limited-production "revival" model with only 2,000 units made, called RV8 was produced by Rover in the 1990s. Despite the similarity in appearance to the roadster, the RV8 had less than 5 percent parts interchangeability with the original car.
