4. Epinephrine. Epinephrine ("adrenalin") is a nonselective agonist of all adrenergic receptors, including the major subtypes α 1, α 2, β 1, β 2, and β 3. Epinephrine increases SVR via α 1 receptor-dependent vasoconstriction (Fig. 3-3) and increases cardiac output via its binding to β 1 receptors.
